PATIO BENCH AND TABLE NAMING

Founded in 1928, International House Berkeley opened its doors in August 1930 to welcome scholars from around the world and throughout the U.S. Since then, more than 90,000 alumni have benefited from residential and cultural programs and services shaped by the House's mission: *To foster intercultural respect and understanding, lifelong friendships and leadership skills for the promotion of a more tolerant and peaceful world.*

Engraved plaques will be placed on a patio bench outside the International House Café or on a table of your choice in the I-House Library. Each sponsored bench or table will be a visible part of the House for years to come.

- up to 3 lines per bench plaque 2" x 6"
- up to 5 lines per table plaque 3" x 8"
- 40 characters per line (including spaces and punctuation)

- \$10,000 Library Table Naming (15 available)
- \$20,000 Dining Commons Table Naming (20 available)
