# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This is the International House Non-Resident Membership application. The undersigned in applying to become an International House Non-Resident Member agrees to abide by the following Terms and Conditions:

Respecting the purpose and mission of International House

- Cooperating with the International House staff in the exercise of their responsibilities
- Respecting residents and those areas designated for residents only, as well as events that are limited to residents only.

Only attend events designated for non-resident members

- I-House Non-Resident Members are responsible for abiding to the UC Berkeley and International House Rules of Conduct. International House Rules of Conduct include, but are not limited to, a prohibition against:

- a) Manufacture, use, sale, or consumption of illegal drugs
- b) Possession of weapons explosives or flammable liquids
- c) Tampering with fire, safety or elevator equipment
- d) Physical, psychological, sexual or racial harassment
- e) Noise that unreasonably disrupts the I-House community
- f) Unlawful manufacture, sale, use or distribution of alcoholic beverages

I, the undersigned, agree to the above terms and conditions and understand that at any time, International House may revoke my Non-Resident Membership privileges if I do not comply to the above terms and conditions.
