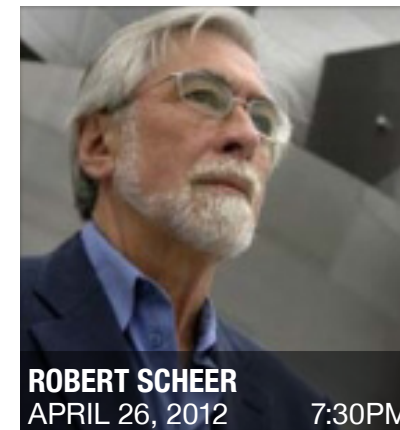
The New Industrial Revolution
