# **Application Instructions**

Applications for partial room and board financial aid are available to graduate or upper division registered international students, US citizens and permanent residents who have demonstrated financial need and meet all other qualifications. Applicants must be registered in a degree-seeking academic program at UC Berkeley and have an I-House Room Contract for spring 2022 to be eligible for financial aid.

The purpose of the financial aid program is to offer UC Berkeley students who demonstrate financial need an opportunity to experience firsthand cultures from all over the world while enabling international students to learn about the ethnic and economic diversity in the United States.

The summary is where you briefly state your key issues for the Scholarship Committee's review, not as an outline of your essay. **PDF files are not accepted**.
