APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Applications for partial room and board financial aid are available to graduate or upper division registered international students, US citizens and permanent US residents who have demonstrated financial need and meet all other qualifications. To be eligible to apply for IH Financial Aid, applicants must be registered in a degree-seeking academic program at UC Berkeley for the Spring, 2023 semester. If you applied for and received a scholarship for the 2022-2023 Academic Year, you are not eligible for additional scholarships. If you were a Fall 2022 Only resident, received a scholarship for the Fall and have since extended your booking to the Spring, you are eligible to apply.

The purpose of the financial aid program is to offer UC Berkeley students who demonstrate financial need, an opportunity to experience firsthand cultures from all over the world while enabling international students to learn about the ethnic and economic diversity in the United States.

If you are interested in applying for financial assistance, please follow the steps listed below.

Please note: We are only able to provide scholarships to those with a confirmed IHouse booking. While we encourage you to apply if you have not received an offer, we will have to place your scholarship application as "Pending." Should you receive and confirm a housing offer at a later date, we will do our very best to process your scholarship application if funding is still available.

In addition to your essay of 500 words or less, please include a 1-2 paragraph <u>summary</u> (190 words or less) of your essay in the same Word document. This is for you to briefly state your key issues for the financial aid committee's review. PDF files are not accepted.

Please submit your Personal Statement (Essay) and Summary in <u>one</u> Word Doc to the appropriate Financial Aid manager via email attachment by the deadline. Make sure the file title includes your *last and first name*.
