About Ambassador Taylor:

With extensive international business experience, Ken began his career in the Canadian Foreign Service and held senior diplomatic positions around the world in a 25-year career. In 1979, while serving as the Canadian Ambassador in Iran, he played a key role in helping six Americans escape from Iran during the hostage crisis which was portrayed in the 2012 movie *Argo*. Comparing reality with the movie's dramatized depiction which highlighted the American role in the operation, Former President Jimmy Carter stated that "the main hero in my view was Ken Taylor."
